PSO Collaboration Community

The Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality and the Patient Safety Organization Privacy Protection Center (PSOPPC) are providing you the opportunity to participate in a new feature to the PSOPPC website called the **PSO Collaboration Community**. The idea for this community grew out of the *2018 PSO Summit to Address the Opioid Crisis*, where PSOs enthusiastically supported development of a venue to share information (such as tools, alerts, and updates) with each other in a timely and secure fashion.

Key Benefits

The PSO Collaboration Community allows PSOs to stay informed all year round, beyond the PSO Annual Meeting. PSOs can share materials and collaborate with one another through the creation of discussion groups within the community. PSOs will also have the ability to ask questions and create polls for other PSOs to provide informative feedback.

How It Works

Registered PSOPPC users will access the Community from the secure pages of the PSOPPC website. On the leftside navigational menu, users will have access to the PSO Collaboration Community portal as seen below:
